OPTION A:

A master class taught to students by trumpet player Doug Woolverton. Doug has performed with such musical icons as Aretha Franklin, John Scofield, J Giles, Bernard Purdy and the list goes on. He is also featured in his own critically acclaimed show: A Tribute to Miles Davis.

Doug offers technique & instrument tips, performance advice, the importance of reading musical charts, tips for working professionally as a musician and is always willing to answer any question the kids pose.

OPTION B:

A master class by bassist and lead vocalist, Mason Swearingen. Mason studied voice with world renowned vocal coach Don Lawrence (Lady Gaga, Jon Bob Jovi, Natalie Cole). He also spent years touring in support of such artists as Peter Frampton, Joe Walsh, Bret Michaels, and even Chicago.

Mason offers students vocal training advice, performance tips, advice on taking care of your voice for multiple performances, singing with and without the use of microphones, and advice for stringed instruments. Mason is also the leader of the band and is able to offer students advice regarding working in the music industry, making money with music, how to find and work with agents, managers, club owners and all facets of live performance.
